<b>FOD-2A</b>	Managing patients <b>ADMITTED</b> to <b>ACUTE</b> care settings with common medical problems and advancing their care plans: <b>PATIENT ASSESSMENT &amp; MANAGEMENT</b>	<b>1</b>
<b>COD-5</b>	Performing the <b>PROCEDURES</b> of Internal Medicine	<b>Always do when you can</b>
<b>COD-8</b>	Caring for patients who have experienced a patient <b>SAFETY INCIDENT</b>	<b>Always do when you can</b>
<b>FOD-3</b>	<b>CONSULTING SPECIALISTS</b> and other health professionals, synthesizing recommendations, and integrating these into the care plan	<b>1-2</b>
<b>FOD-6</b>	Discussing and establishing patients' <b>GOALS OF CARE</b>	<b>1-2</b>
