FOD-3	CONSULTING SPECIALISTS and other health professionals, synthesizing recommendations, and integrating these into the care plan	1-2
FOD-5	Assessing UNSTABLE PATIENTS , providing targeted treatment and consulting as needed	2
FOD-6	Discussing and establishing patients' GOALS OF CARE	1-2
FOD-1	Assessing, diagnosing and providing INITIAL MANAGEMENT for patients with common ACUTE medical presentations in acute care settings	2
FOD-2A	Managing patients ADMITTED to ACUTE care settings with common medical problems and advancing their care plans: PATIENT ASSESSMENT & MANAGEMENT	1
COD-5	Performing the PROCEDURES of Internal Medicine	Always do when you can
COD-8	Caring for patients who have experienced a patient SAFETY INCIDENT	Always do when you can
