

## Clinician Scientist (CS) Academic Position Description

Recommended timeframes: 10% time = one half day = four - five hours = 0.5 ER shifts

## **Characteristics:**

Of the professional time spent in academic work, the academic work time will be divided as follows:	
Percent of professional time spent in clinical care	10-25%

Examples of formal teaching activities appropriate to CS	All types of graduate teaching and supervision; supervision of learner research projects; PG academic half-day/ other educational programs; CE
<b>Percent of professional time protected for</b> <b>scholarly activities</b> (CPA and Research, not the time involved in clinical activities or teaching)	70-80%
Examples of scholarship appropriate to CS	PI on at least one peer reviewed operating grant and ≥ two first- or senior-authored peer reviewed manuscripts per year over a three-year period + evidence of research impact - local, national, international
Administrative Service (hospital, department, university) *Applies to Full-time Clinical Faculty Only	<ul> <li>For full-time clinical faculty, Prior to Continuing Faculty Appointment Review (CFAR): not required and not recommended, except when directly relevant to scholarly or teaching interests.</li> <li>Post CFAR: full-time clinical faculty members are expected to contribute five to 10% of their time to service to the hospital, department and/or University. Service to the University includes activities such as serving on grant review panels, work with national societies or the Royal College, etc. that does not directly benefit the individual.</li> <li>CFAR neither applies to part-time nor adjunct clinical faculty.</li> </ul>
