COD-2A	Assessing and managing patients with complex CHRONIC conditions: ASSESSMENT & RX	2
COD-2B	Assessing and managing patients with complex chronic conditions: <b>COMMUNICATION</b>	2
COD-3A	Providing internal medicine <b>CONSULTATION</b> to other services: <b>PATIENT ASSESSMENT &amp;</b> <b>DECISION MAKING</b>	2
COD-7	DISCUSSING SERIOUS OR COMPLEX AREAS OF CARE with patients, families, and caregivers	2
COD-8	Caring for patients who have experienced a patient <b>SAFETY INCIDENT</b>	Always do when you can
COD-1	Assessing diagnosing & managing patients with complex or atypical ACUTE MEDICAL PRESENTATIONS	Optional (0-1)
COD-3C	Providing internal medicine CONSULTATION to other services: ORAL COMMUNICATION	Optional (0-1)
