Code	EPA Name	# Needed/Block (8 total + COD-5 & COD-8)
COD-9A	Caring for patients at the END OF LIFE: SYMPTOM MANAGEMENT in End of Life Care	2
COD-1	Assessing, diagnosing & managing patients with complex or atypical <b>ACUTE</b> medical presentations	2
COD-3A	Providing internal medicine CONSULTATION to other services: PATIENT ASSESSMENT & DECISION MAKING	2
COD-7	DISCUSSING SERIOUS OR COMPLEX AREAS OF CARE with patients, families, and caregivers	2
COD-5	Performing the <b>PROCEDURES</b> of Internal Medicine	Always do when you can
COD-8	Caring for patients who have experienced a patient <b>SAFETY INCIDENT</b>	Always do when you can
COD-4A	Assessing UNSTABLE PATIENTS, providing targeted treatment and consulting as needed: PATIENT CARE	Optional (0-1)
COD-6	ASSESSING CAPACITY for medical decision making	Optional (0-1)
COD-9B	Caring for patients at the END OF LIFE: DISCUSSION about transition away from disease modifying treatment	Optional (0-1)
