COD-6	ASSESSING CAPACITY for medical decision-making	2
COD-7	DISCUSSION SRIOUS OR COMPLEX AREAS OF CARE with patients, families, and caregivers	2
COD-9A	Caring for patients at the <b>END OF LIFE:</b> Part A: <b>SYMPTOM MANAGEMENT</b> in End of Life Care	2
COD-9B	Caring for patients at the END OF LIFE: Part B: DISCUSSION about transition away from disease modifying treatment	2
COD-5	Performing the <b>PROCEDURES</b> of Internal Medicine	Always do when you can
COD-8	Caring for patients who have experienced a patient <b>SAFETY INCIDENT</b>	Always do when you can
COD- 3A	Providing internal medicine CONSULTATION to other services: PATIENT ASSESSMENT & DECISION MAKING	Optional (0-1)
COD-3B	Providing internal medicine CONSULTATION to other services: WRITTEN COMMUNICATION	Optional (0-1)
COD-3C	Providing internal medicine CONSULTATION to other services: ORAL COMMUNICATION	Optional (0-1)
