



Curriculum Plan for PGY4 Foundations of Discipline (FOD: PGY4, Months 2-6)

The table below outlines the required EPAs by rotation.

Residents are expected to complete 7 EPAs to complete FOD. There are also site-specific COD EPAs that should be completed on each Core hospital rotation at that site, even if they are completing the rotation in the first half of the PGY4 year.

	SHSC: FOD1 (2), FOD2 (1), FOD3 (2), FOD4 (2)- do 2 each month COD1 – complete once on whole rotation COD5 (2-SHSC: CGM – complete twice on whole rotation)	
	UHN/SHS: FOD1 (2), FOD2 (1), FOD3 (2), FOD4 (2)- do 2 each month COD1 - complete once on whole rotation COD5 (UHN/SHS: Pregnancy in diabetes) – complete twice on whole rotation	
	WCH: FOD1 (2), FOD2 (1), FOD3 (2), FOD4 (2)- do 2 each month COD1 - complete once on whole rotation COD9 (WCH) – complete twice on whole rotation	
Longitudinal Clinic	FOD1 (2), FOD2 (3), FOD3 (2), FOD4 (1) – do 2 each month	COD4, COD5, COD6, COD8
Peds	FOD3 (genital exam (1)) + one more of any FOD EPA COD9 (1)	
Community	Complete 1-2 of any FOD EPA	COD1

FOD1	Assessing and managing individuals with an uncomplicated presentation of an endocrine condition
FOD2	Providing ongoing care for individuals with an uncomplicated presentation of an endocrine condition
FOD3	Performing endocrine-focused physical examinations
FOD4	Counselling patients and families for the purposes of patient education, disease prevention, and/or health promotion
COD1	Managing patients presenting with an emergency related to an endocrine condition or its treatment
COD2	Assessing and managing patients with complex and/or atypical presentations
COD3	Providing ongoing care
COD4	Interpreting investigations
COD5	Managing diabetes with insulin therapy and the use of diabetes technologies
COD6	Documenting patient encounters
COD7	Providing indirect patient management recommendations to other health care professionals
COD8	Providing unplanned advice to patients
COD9	Supporting adolescents/young adults with endocrine disease in the transition from the pediatric to adult care setting
COD10	Leading patient care on an inpatient consultation service
