#### EPA code EPA Name

**TTD1** Assessing patients with a known endocrine condition

FOD1 Assessing and managing individuals with an uncomplicated presentation of an endocrine condition

FOD2 Providing ongoing care for individuals with an uncomplicated presentation of an endocrine condition

**FOD3** Performing endocrine-focused physical examinations

FOD4 Counselling patients and families for the purposes of patient education, disease prevention, and/or health promotion

**COD1** Managing patients presenting with an emergency related to an endocrine condition or its treatment

COD2 Assessing and managing patients with complex and/or atypical presentations

COD3 Providing ongoing care

COD4 Interpreting investigations

COD5 Managing diabetes with insulin therapy and the use of diabetes technologies

COD6 Documenting patient encounters

COD7 Providing indirect patient management recommendations to other health care professionals

COD8 Providing unplanned advice to patients

COD9 Supporting adolescents/young adults with endocrine disease in the transition from the pediatric to adult care setting

COD10 Leading patient care on an inpatient consultation service
